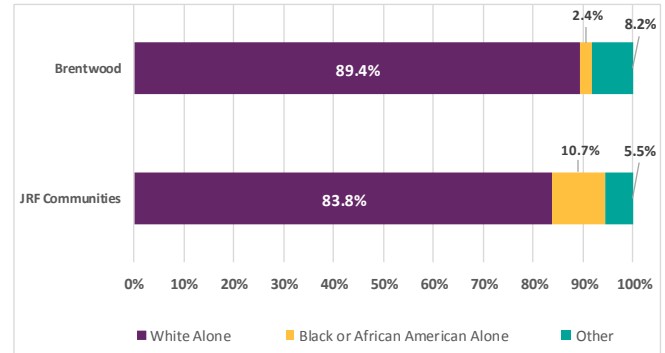

Population: 9,625

Population by Race/Ethnicity (2014):

- As of 2014, Brentwood’s total population was estimated at 9,625.
- The racial/ethnic composition of Brentwood is 89.4% white, 2.4% African American and 8.2% other races.
- 14% of the total population is over age 65 — lower than the JRF Communities (18%) and the same as the City of Pittsburgh. Brentwood residents between the ages of 18–64 make up 66% of the population and under 18 account for 20% of the population.
- The median age for Brentwood is 40. This is lower than Allegheny County (41) and higher than the city of Pittsburgh (33).

- In 2014, 738 residents of Brentwood (8% of the total population) received SNAP benefits.

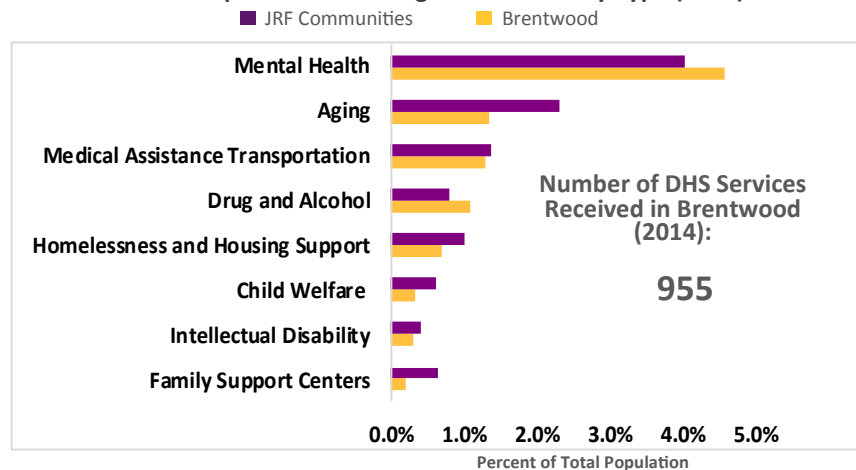

Aging and Mental Health Services were the most utilized for both—though a lower percent of Brentwood residents utilized Aging services.
